Bright, pale yellow. With its aromas of pineapple, powdered stone and tea leaf, this smells a bit sweeter than the Genevrières. Dense but light on its feet, with terrific inner-mouth perfume to the flavours of lavender, powdered stone and minerals. Taut, elegant, very dry wine with superb cut and rising length. A very clear expression of Perrières terroir.

Long, cool fermentation in barrel; 15-30% new and the rest are one-year-old.

MATURATION
